Sensory Friendly Night: Easter Adventure—Children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and sensory processing differences are invited to have a fun, enjoyable, and interactive learning experience in a comfortable and accepting environment! Create a bunny craft, enjoy a storytime, and hunt for eggs! Children will have an opportunity to trade in their empty eggs for a surprise. Sensory Friendly Nights are offered quarterly. Admission is \$3/person for members and non-members.

Sensory Friendly Monday—Children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and sensory processing differences are invited to have a fun, enjoyable, and interactive learning experience in a comfortable and accepting environment! Sensory Friendly Mondays are offered one day per month, September – May, on Members Only Mondays (9 am - 12 pm) when attendance is light. You do not need to be a member in order to attend, but admission or membership is required.

Discovery Club—remaining dates: April 24, May 22. Children ages 3-4 years old experience immersive, hands-on learning in this one-of-a-kind environment, and develop skills that support the natural curiosity of young learners. Day-of registration available at the door if space is available—\$12/class.
