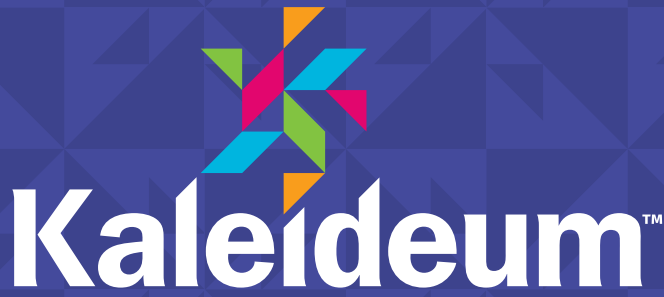

## Say Hello to Kaleideum!

On February 7, the Children's Museum of Winston-Salem and SciWorks announced the merged organization's new name: Kaleideum! The museums will remain in two separate locations for the next few years before they move to a new downtown site. The former Children's Museum is now called Kaleideum Downtown, and the former SciWorks is now called Kaleideum North.



The inspiration for the name came from the idea of a kaleidoscope: a simple scientific instrument and toy that also creates beautiful art when you look inside. The kaleidoscope represents the perfect

blend of art, creativity, and science, and the instrument itself is a free-choice learning experience that encourages individuals to explore and learn more.
