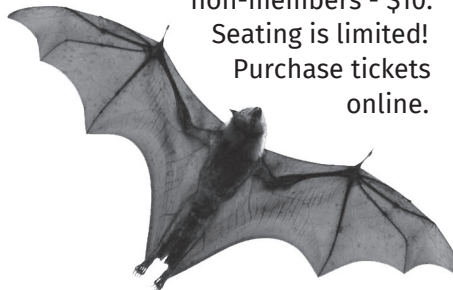
Live Night Creatures

Sunday, May 21, 1-4 pm

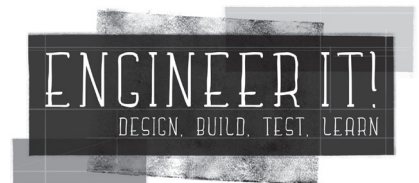
