At the Museum, learning can be verbal or non-verbal; hands-on or hands-off; fast or slow; social or solitary; loud or quiet; directed or inquiry-based. Sensory Friendly Mondays are offered one day per month, September through May, on Members-only Mondays (9 am - 12 pm) when Museum attendance is light. You do not need to be a member in order to attend, but admission or membership is required.
