Preschool Discovery — An action-packed program including stories, music, movement, and more!

Kids Rock Music — Join us for live music, age-appropriate instruments, and interactive movement! Kids Rock Music brings the joy of musical expression to children and families.

Little Tykes — This program focuses specifically on the developmental skills and interests of young children, age 2 years old! Children and their caregivers will engage one-on-one through songs, stories, creating crafts, and special activities. Discover the magic of playing and learning together! Day-of registration is available beginning 15 minutes before the start of each program, but space is limited—\$8/class for member child (one free adult), \$10/class for non-member child (one free adult, Kaleideum Downtown admission included.)

Sensory Friendly Monday — Children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and sensory processing differences are invited to have a fun, enjoyable, and interactive learning experience in a comfortable and accepting environment! Music & Movement — Come move and groove through songs, fingerplays, and a read aloud. Your child will gain meaningful skills to build upon their language, listening, and physical abilities.
