Science Café at Reynolda Gardens

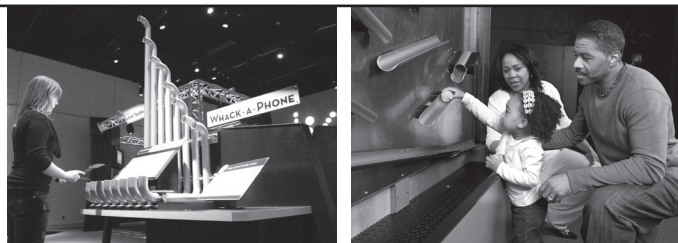
Tuesday, November 14, 7 pm
