You do not need to be a member in order to attend, but admission or membership is required. Our Sensory Friendly Monday modifications include choice boards and a designated quiet room. Colin Allured Concert—Come sing and dance along to an uplifting array of favorite children's songs. From traditional classics to more contemporary songs from your child's favorite shows and movies, this concert will bring musical joy to children and parents alike.

COMING IN APRIL

In early April, the curtain will open on a brand new theatre-themed exhibit and makerspace: **The Prop Shop**. Within this space, visitors can gather to create, invent, tinker, explore, and discover. The exhibit and its related programming will support learner-driven experiences that engage children, families, and school groups in open-ended, problem-solving processes that integrate experimentation and creativity. Real tools and materials are available for visitors to design and create their own puppets, costumes, set pieces, and props. Facilitated programming focuses on children ages 4-12 and their caregivers. To give older family members time to create, the space will also include exhibit activities to engage younger children, including a small theatre-themed toddler area. Additional exhibit components include a functional animatronic chameleon, sculpting station, and an interactive loft exploring elements of lighting and sound. With the opening of **The Prop Shop**, Kaleideum will offer a transformative space filled with multi-faceted, open-ended experiences centered around the performing arts, allowing children to test theories, seek answers to questions, think critically, persevere, perform, and explore at their own pace — all while building and strengthening skills for their future success in any area.
