Position Summary: The summer camp assistant teacher will assist will all daily programs and activities scheduled for the 4^{th} - 6^{th} grade summer camp. Candidates interested in this position must be reliable, punctual, thorough, and enthusiastic. They must be available to teach the weeks of June 18^{th} - 29^{th} and July 9^{th} - August 17^{th} .

Assist with all other summer camp responsibilities as schedule dictates.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with setting up the room prior to camp and cleaning up each day
- Attend orientation at the beginning of each week
- Familiarize yourself with camp outlines for each week
- Supervise campers and student volunteers throughout the week
- Familiarize yourself with any behavior and medical issues including allergies
- Prepare drink and snack each day
- Assist teacher setting up individual activities throughout the day
- Communicate with teacher and supervisor immediately if there are behavior problems, accidents, or injuries with the kids
- Supervise kids during lunch
- Interact with kids throughout the day
- Follow all organization policies and procedures
- Other duties as assigned
